JOB DESCRIPTION: Responsible for providing quality care and programming for children based on the E.L.E.C.T. Framework and *How Does Learning Happen? Ontario's Pedagogy for the Early Years*, before and after school within a school age program. Act as a resource to parents and colleagues. Provide direction to students, volunteers and substitute staff. Work with Manager and Lead Educator to ensure policies and procedures are followed.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Early Childhood Education diploma/degree from recognized college/university preferred with membership in good standing with College of ECE, if eligible
- Solid understanding of child development
- Excellent communication skills
- Sensitivity and respect for individual and cultural differences
- Ability to work independently and reliably in a team, and a flexible fast paced environment with minimal supervision
- Excellent interpersonal skills, energy and enthusiasm
- Physically able to participate with children indoors/outdoors and to set up and take down program equipment
- Working knowledge of Child Care and Early Years Act, 2014 (CCEYA), Emergent Curriculum and ELECT Framework is an asset
- Experience working with children with special needs is an asset
- Ability to use a computer and other office equipment and work with various software programs (Microsoft Word, Excel, database, etc.)
- Valid Standard First Aid and CPR (including Infant and Child); a vulnerable sector police records check; and an updated immunization report are required.
